The Quarterly District Export Promotion Committee Meeting for the year 2024-25 was convened on 16.12.2024 at 4.30 pm at District Collectorate, Tiruchirappalli under the Chairmanship of Thiru.M.Pradeep Kumar, I.A.S., Chairman, DEPC / District Collector, Tiruchirappalli. The General Manager, District Industries Centre, Trichy welcomed the Members present online as well as offline. Successively, the need for Export Data Collection has been emphasized by the General Manager, District Industries Centre - Tiruchirappalli.

**Export Data Collection: -**

- The District Collector reiterated on the Export Data Collection and requested the committee to devise an action Plan for Data Collection.
- The District Collector insisted to utilize the data available in the UDYAM Registration Portal, ZED and GeM Portals and instructed the state holders to conduct awareness programs on the Export Promotion and Export Credit schemes.

**Infrastructure Facilities for Export oriented units: -**

- The District Collector advised the committee to analyse the infrastructure facilities available in Trichy District for the Promotion of the Engineering Goods, which is the Focus product for Export promotion at District Level.
- It is noted that Perishable food Products such as fruits, vegetable, flowers and milk products are being exported from Trichy through Passenger flight on availability basis only, leading to return and redirection of the Product to other Airport Terminals. Hence, to cater the need for Export, a specific Cargo Plane for Trichy would be a much-needed requirement for Export Promotion in this region. Which is recommended by Export Import Federation and President, TIDITSSIA Tiruchirappalli
- The Export Import Federation requested a dedicated Export Terminal in Tiruchirappalli Airport so called as "Dry Port "/ Inland Container Depo (ICD) at Trichy as Full Container Load (FCL) Exclusively to be available for the industries located in and around Tiruchirappalli region.
